UMPIRES POLICY

ADVERSE WEATHER AFFECTED MATCHES

In the event of matches being interrupted by rain or extreme temperatures, the following procedures will take place.

In the event that no play is possible for the day then the umpires are to be notified as soon as reasonable practical in order to prevent the umpires from turning up at the ground.

If the umpires are required to be at the ground then the following will apply:

It will be at the absolute discretion of the umpires if and when play should commence if at all. Should the umpires deem that no play is possible from the outset or within 90 minutes of the scheduled start then there umpires will be paid \$20.00 for that day.

If the umpires are required to make subsequent inspections after 90 minutes of the scheduled start and there is still no play the umpires are entitled to one half days pay.

If the umpires have been in attendance for more than 3 hours then they shall be entitled to a full days pay irrespective of whether there has been any play or not.

FORFEIT

In the event of a forfeit, the umpire shall be notified as soon as reasonable practical in order to prevent the umpire from turning up at the ground.

If the umpire and teams are at the ground, then if a team does not have 8 correctly attired players ready to commence play, weather permitting, by 2.00pm then that team will be deemed to have forfeited the match.

The umpires will be paid \$20.00 providing that the match is called off within 90 minutes of the scheduled starting time.
