Reciprocal Rights

Visiting members must be on a short term visit to be eligible for reciprocal rights at the Gabba. Under no circumstances will Reciprocal Rights be granted on more than three matches in any one membership year (1 September to 31 August).

Reciprocal Rights apply to members of:

- Melbourne Cricket Club (Voting Members only)
- South Australian Cricket Association (SACA Provisional members do not have Reciprocal Rights)
- Sydney Cricket Ground
- Tasmanian Cricket Association (including Full members of the NTCA and NWTCA)
- WACA
- ANZ Stadium Club
- English County Grounds and Overseas Test Cricket Grounds

but are NOT available to persons living in Queensland.

Reciprocal rights at the Gabba apply to AFL fixtures upon payment of the daily admission fee.

Guests

Reciprocal members may also bring up to two paying guests to any match day for which reciprocal rights apply (or where advised otherwise), subject to ground capacity limits.*

**Ticketing information is correct at the time of going to press however, restrictions may be placed on the number of daily guest tickets available during the season (depending on anticipated crowd attendance and operational requirements). Management reserves the right to restrict the number of reciprocal member and guest tickets available. The Gabba and Stadiums Queensland accepts no responsibility for subsequent changes. Members of other grounds seeking reciprocal rights are encouraged to contact the Gabba before travelling to confirm if restrictions have been placed on matches.*



Access to Members' Reserve

Reciprocal members who purchase tickets and then go away, returning later, may find that, if all the seats have been taken, they and their guests cannot be admitted to the Members' Reserve.

By law, once all seats in the Members' Reserve have been taken, no one else may be admitted to the Members' Reserve, even if they have reciprocal rights or a daily guest ticket.

Tickets

Persons seeking reciprocal rights must attend the Members Match Day Office at Gate 5 (in Vulture Street opposite Duke Street) from gate opening time on match day to complete the reciprocal rights book, show their current Membership medallion or card and provide proof of their current address.

Reciprocal members may purchase tickets for the Members' Reserve for the AFL Season at the daily admission fee. Children under 4 are admitted free provided they do not occupy a seat.

If Reciprocal Members wish to purchase tickets prior to the match day, they may purchase public tickets through Ticketmaster www.ticketmaster.com.au and swap for members tickets (subject to availability) on the match day from the Members Match Day Office.

Dress Regulations

The Gabba considers it desirable that a reasonable standard of dress, consistent with the prestige of being a member of a major sporting venue, is maintained by both its Members and their guests.

The minimum standard of dress is neat, smart casual for both men and women.

Males (12 years and over) must wear a collared shirt irrespective of whether or not a collared jacket or sweater is being worn over the shirt.

Shorts and pants must be of dress style. Denim is acceptable. Football style shorts, brief or tight shorts, boxer shorts, tracksuit pants or leggings are not acceptable. Swimsuits, midriff tops and clothing with offensive words or symbols are not acceptable. Ragged, torn or unclean clothing is not acceptable.

Dress Regulations (continued)

Males: Sandals (with back/strap) and “runner” type shoes are permitted providing they are clean and in good condition. Thongs (both rubber and fashion dress), masseurs, scuffs, slides, slippers, ugg boots and dilapidated footwear are NOT acceptable.

Females: Fashion shoes (not rubber), sandals and “runner” type shoes are permitted providing they are clean and in good condition. Rubber thongs, masseurs, slippers, ugg boots and dilapidated footwear are NOT acceptable.

Notwithstanding the outlined Dress regulations, management reserves the right to refuse entry to the Members Reserve to any person considered not suitably attired.
