MEMBERS OF INTERSTATE RECIPROCAL CLUBS/VENUES GUIDE FOR 2011/2012 CRICKET SEASON

Dear Reciprocal Member,

Thank you for your interest in attending fixtures during the 2011/2012 cricket season at the Melbourne Cricket Ground.

Members of interstate reciprocal clubs/venues will have restricted entry entitlements to the MCC Members Reserve for the 2011/2012 cricket season. Entry and all match day ticketing will be via Gate 2, near the corner of Jolimont Street and Jolimont Terrace.

Important Information

- Please note that members of interstate reciprocal clubs/venues will have entry entitlements into the MCC Members Reserve for Days 4 - 5 of the Test match, the two One-day internationals, the Twenty20 international and all domestic matches involving the Victorian Bushrangers and Melbourne Stars.
- Only Full members of affiliated reciprocal clubs/venues on a short term visit to Victoria will have entry entitlements. *Associate, guest and corporate memberships have no access rights.*
- Members must provide their Full membership card as well as identification confirming their residence outside Victoria before any applications will be processed.
- There is a limit of 200 tickets per international match day for members and guests of interstate reciprocal clubs/venues. You are encouraged to pre-purchase your required ticketing to avoid disappointment on the day.
- For the Test match, One-day internationals and the Twenty20 international reciprocal members and their guests will be given access to unreserved seating on Levels 1 and 4 of the MCC Reserve. No access will be available to the Long Room, Members Dining Room, Frank Grey Smith Bar or MCC 'member-only' seating areas on Levels 2 and 3. (Please refer to the seating plan map in this guide for clarification)
- Bistro-style meals will be available in the Hugh Trumble Café (Level 1), while light snack meals will be served in the Percy Beames Bar and Members Café (Level 2). Despite the aforementioned facilities and seating areas of the Reserve being open to MCC members only, reciprocal members and their guests are permitted access to all other bar and dining facilities and seating areas inside the Members Reserve. (Please refer to the map of the Members Reserve in this guide)
- The MCC reserves the right to discontinue the sale of reciprocal and visitor tickets for any match day. Under no circumstances will a ticket be sold to a reciprocal member if they are not available to MCC members' guests at the time.
- Please note all tickets purchased are non-refundable.

Dress Code

The minimum dress standard in the Members Reserve is neat casual. Denim is acceptable; however gentlemen must wear a collared shirt even if worn under a collared jacket or sweater at all times in the Reserve. T-shirts, singlets, beach wear, tracksuit pants, overalls or torn or ripped clothes, and clothing displaying racist or offensive messages are not accepted.

Non-acceptable footwear includes thongs, scuffs, dilapidated footwear, gumboots, moccasins, slippers and ugg boots.

Days 4 - 5 Thursday December 29, 2011 – Friday December 30, 2011

- Reciprocal members are eligible to purchase an entry ticket for themselves and up to two (2) visitor tickets for guests.

Note: Tickets for Day 5 can only be purchased on the day.

Domestic Cricket – Access Entitlements

SHEFFIELD SHIELD, ONE-DAY CUP AND TWENTY20 BIG BASH LEAGUE MATCHES

Reciprocal members will be able to obtain a complimentary pass that will allow access to all areas in the Reserve including the Long Room, subject to appropriate dress standards being met (i.e. jacket and tie for gentlemen and equivalent standard for women).

Reciprocal members will also be able to purchase up to four (4) visitor tickets for guests.

All ticketing for domestic matches can be obtained from the Membership Services Office at Gate 2 on the particular match day.



How to purchase tickets

IN ADVANCE

Tickets for international matches can be pre-purchased by completing the attached application form. Pre-purchased tickets can then be collected from the Envelope Collection Windows next to the Members Reserve entrance at Gate 2 on the match day.

ON MATCH DAY

Subject to availability, tickets can be purchased from the Membership Services Windows next to the Members Reserve entrance at Gate 2.

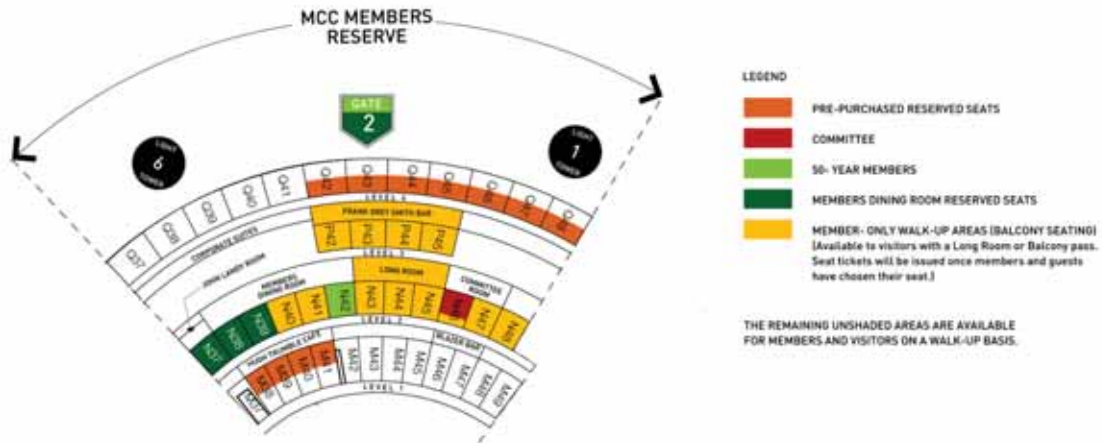
** Please note that when collecting pre-purchased tickets or purchasing tickets on the day, the member must provide their membership card and identification confirming residency outside Victoria.*

Reciprocal members will have access to unreserved seating on level 1(M section) and level 4 (Q section) of the Members Reserve.

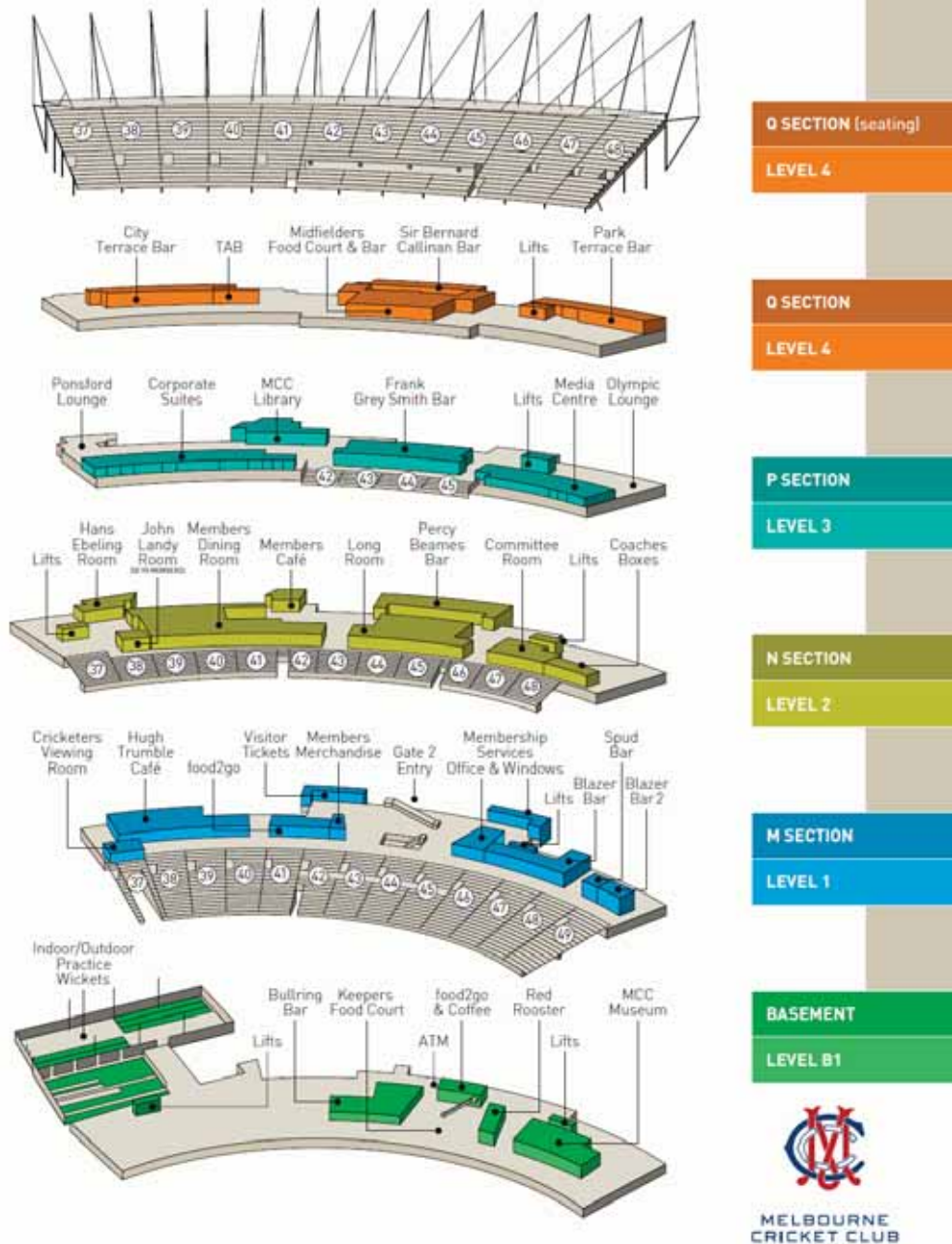
Level 2 (N section) and Level 3 (P section) are member-only seating areas.
