

RECIPROCAL CLUBS GUIDE FOR QLD CRICKETERS' CLUB FOR 2024 AFL SEASON AND 2024/25 CRICKET SEASON



Members of reciprocal Clubs will have entry entitlements into the QCC for the 2024 AFL season with restricted entitlements for Carlton, Collingwood & Geelong matches only (maximum 2 tickets only).

Full restrictions will also apply to Day 1 and 2 of the Test Match with access to tickets from Day 3 onwards.

Important Information

Only Full Members of affiliated reciprocal clubs/venues will receive entry entitlements. Social, Guest or Local Members will have no access rights.

Reciprocal members are eligible to purchase guest tickets for themselves and any additional guests, with prices ranging from \$85.00ea to \$130.00ea for the 2024 AFL and 2024/25 BBL season, and under 18 child tickets from \$50.00ea to \$90.00ea dependant on the match in question. A maximum of 2 tickets will apply to any finals matches should they occur, subject to availability. Day 3 and 4 range from \$120 - \$150 for Reciprocal Adults and \$70 - \$90 for those under 18.

Members must state their Reciprocal Club & membership number on the booking form when applying for tickets and provide a copy of their Member card or a letter of introduction from their Club with the application. Reciprocal Members are encouraged to purchase their match day tickets through QCC ahead of the match day to avoid disappointment, as tickets may not be available on the day at the Club.

Once tickets have been secured, Reciprocal Members and their guests will be given access to the Qld Cricketers' Club on a match day, plus will receive a reserved stadium seat directly in front of the QCC for the match purchased (sections 237, 238 and 239 of the stadium). No access will be available into the Wisden Room at any time.

Reciprocal Members may book formal dining within the Club for a match day at the time of purchasing tickets. Dining bookings cannot be made on the match day and must be pre-booked, subject to availability. Café food is available for purchase within the Qld Cricketers' Club each match day.

All tickets are non-refundable except where required by law.

Dress Code

The minimum dress standard in the Qld Cricketers' Club is smart casual.

Denim is acceptable, however men must wear a shirt supported by a collar at all times and denim must not be ripped, torn or stonewashed. T-shirts, singlets, shorts, tracksuit pants, overalls or clothing displaying offensive or racist messages are not acceptable. Footwear must be smart and closed in for men, smart casual for women. Thongs, sneakers, scuffs, slippers, ugg boots or dilapidated footwear is not acceptable.
