Thank you for your interest in attending fixtures during the 2011/2012 cricket season at the Melbourne Cricket Ground.

Important Information

- Please note that members of overseas reciprocal clubs will have complimentary entry entitlements into the MCC Members Reserve for all days of the Boxing Day Test match, the Twenty20 international match, the two One-day internationals and all domestic matches. Members will be issued a pass that will allow them access to all areas in the Reserve, including the Long Room, subject to appropriate dress standards being met (i.e. jacket and tie for gentlemen and equivalent standard for women).
- Only Full members of affiliated reciprocal clubs/venues on a short term visit to Australia will have entry entitlements. *Associate, guest and corporate memberships have no access rights.*
- Members must produce their Full membership card, a Letter of Introduction from their club, as well as identification confirming their residency outside Australia before any reciprocal access or sale of visitor tickets will proceed.
- For the Test match, One-day internationals and the international Twenty20 match, reciprocal members will be able obtain a complimentary pass for themselves and purchase up to two (2) visitor tickets for their guests. Visitors have access to unreserved seating on Levels 1 and 4 of the MCC Members Reserve only. No access will be available to the Long Room or MCC 'member-only' seating areas on Levels 2 and 3 unless available to MCC members' guests through Long Room and Balcony Passes. (Please refer to the seating plan and the facilities map in this guide for clarification)
- Bistro-style meals will be available in the Hugh Trumble Café (Level 1), while light snack meals will be served in the Percy Beames Bar (Level 2), Members Café (Level 2) and Frank Grey Smith Bar (Level 3). While access to the Long Room, Members Dining Room, Frank Grey Smith Bar and seating areas on Levels 2 and 3 of the Reserve will be available to members of overseas reciprocal clubs, guests will not be able to access these areas unless they have a Long Room or Balcony pass.
- You are encouraged to pre-arrange your entry pass and visitor tickets to avoid disappointment. Unfortunately once visitor tickets have sold out for a match there will be no more issued.
- The MCC reserves the right to discontinue the sale of reciprocal and visitor tickets for any match. Under no circumstances will a visitor ticket be sold to a reciprocal member's guest if they are not available to MCC members at the time

How to purchase tickets

IN ADVANCE

Tickets for international matches can be pre-purchased by completing the attached application form. Pre-purchased tickets can then be collected from the Envelope Collection Windows next to the Members Reserve entrance at Gate 2 on the match day.

ON MATCH DAY

Subject to availability, tickets can be purchased from the Membership Services Windows next to the Members Reserve entrance at Gate 2.

** Please note that when collecting pre-purchased tickets or purchasing tickets on the day, the member must provide their membership card, Letter of Introduction and identification confirming residency outside Australia.*

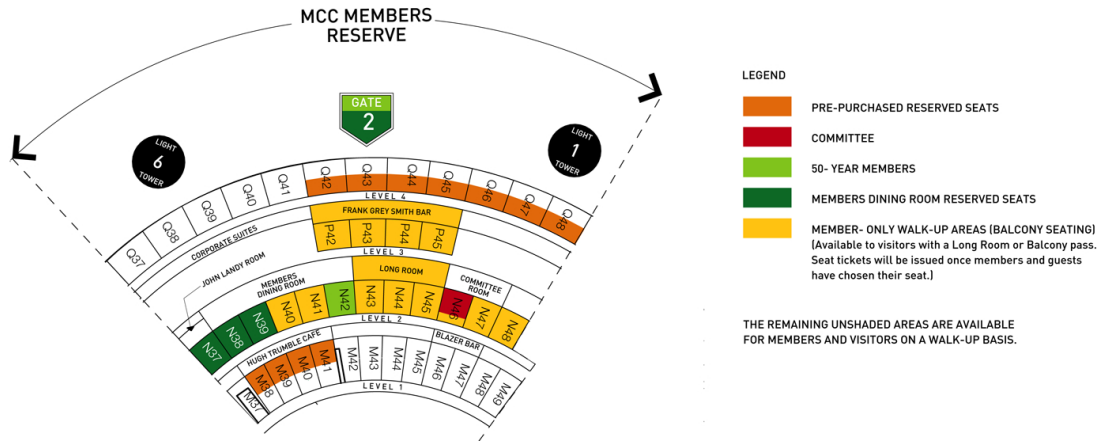

Reciprocal members will have access to unreserved seating on all levels of the Members Reserve.

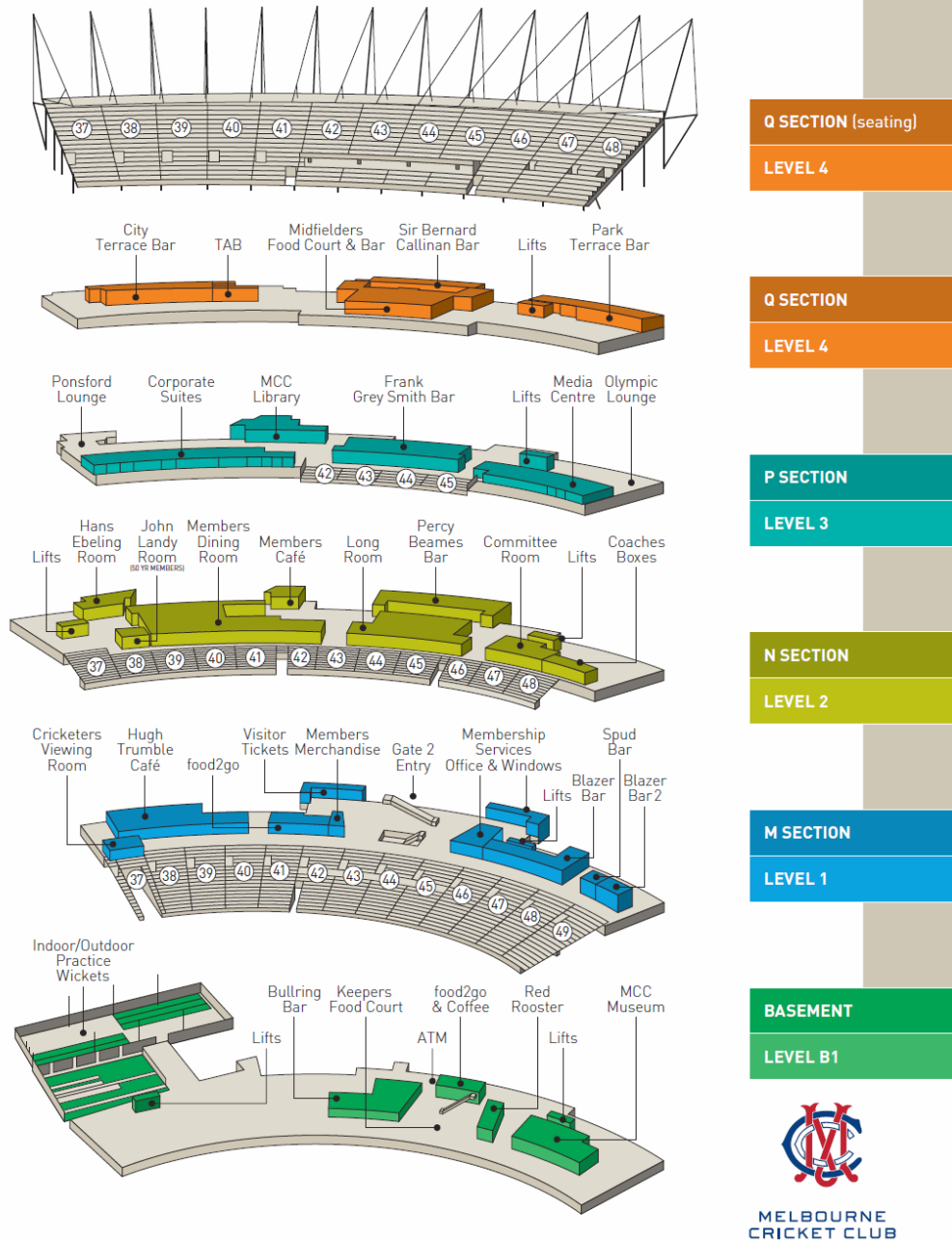
Reciprocal members' guests will only have access to unreserved seating on Level 1 (M section) and Level 4 (Q section) of the Members Reserve.
