

Overseas Reciprocal Access for the 2026 AFL Season

Members of affiliated overseas reciprocal clubs may purchase one ticket for themselves and up to four (4) visitor tickets for all MCG matches, excluding ANZAC Day (limited to two (2) visitor tickets). Access is restricted to Levels 1 and 4.

Associate, guest and corporate memberships are not eligible, and only one membership card may be used for reciprocal access.

Members must provide their membership card, proof of residence outside Australia, and a Letter of Introduction from their club. Applications must be submitted via the online form. Once approved, a payment link (if applicable) will be issued within five (5) business days. Pre-purchasing is strongly recommended to avoid disappointment.
